Aloha Chairwoman King,

I am writing to support Mayor Michael Victorino's appointment of Scott Teruya to the position of Director of Finance. For the past twelve years, I have worked at the Real Property Tax Division as an Appraiser and Appraisal Supervisor under Scott's management. During this time, the RPT Division accomplished the following:

- Completely eliminated its backlog of property tax appeals
- Increased its attention to training and education
- Renewed its focus on policing undeserving agricultural assessments and illegal vacation rentals

These goals would not have been met without Scott's work-ethic and knowledge. I understand the rigorous demands and financial responsibility of being The Director of Finance and I can assure you Scott is willing to seek the knowledge in situations he is unsure of. After seeing Scott's ability first-hand, I know that he would make a great Director of Finance.

That said, the past twelve years have not been a walk in the park. To be frank, the Department of Finance's previously-appointed management did not communicate effectively, misplaced its priorities, and generally lacked the Aloha Spirit required to effectively lead such a diverse group of employees.
