Chair and Members:

Your Economic Development and Budget Committee, having met on February 28, 2019, makes reference to County Communication 18-391, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT, MAUI REDEVELOPMENT PROGRAM; TOTAL OPERATING APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2019 Budget by: (1) increasing Carryover/Savings from the General Fund by \$250,000; (2) amending Section 3.B.8.c., Department of Management, Maui Redevelopment Program, by adding a grant entitled "Grant to Lokahi Pacific, Inc." with an appropriation for Category B (Operations) in the amount of \$250,000; and (3) adjusting the totals accordingly. The funds are to renovate the Harry and Jeanette Weinberg Pono Center at 62 North Market Street, Wailuku, Maui, Hawaii.

2. A Certification of Additional Revenues for FY 2019, dated October 25, 2018, for \$250,000 in Carryover/Savings from the General Fund.

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A representative of the Department of Management said the land is owned by the County and leased to Lokahi Pacific, a nonprofit organization that built the four-story structure in 2006.

The County Communication notes the \$250,000 appropriation would be for the following:

- \$130,000 for "maintenance and repair," including roof replacement; and
- \$120,000 for plans to convert the ground floor into "a single restaurant space" and "a feasibility study to convert the third floor to additional affordable apartment rentals."

Susie Thieman, Executive Director, Lokahi Pacific, informed your Committee of the history of the lease to Lokahi Pacific and construction, use of, and repairs to the building. Ms. Thieman said the appropriation would fund architectural renderings to convert the use of the third floor to six affordable apartments instead of incubator offices.

The representative of the Department of Management said it is advisable to convert the third floor to apartments. She said Lokahi Pacific has an exceptional record in developing and maintaining housing, the existing rental units on the fourth floor of the building have been consistently occupied, and there is a high demand for housing in the area.

Your Committee voted 9-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Rawlins-Fernandez, Vice-Chair King, and members Hokama, Kama, Lee, Molina, Paltin, Sinenci, and Sugimura voted "aye."

Your Committee is in receipt of a revised proposed bill, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions that take into account prior

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amendments to the FY 2019 Budget and adjustments to reflect the expected passage of other pending legislation. The revised proposed bill also updates the year of the bill and changes the name of the entity to "Lokahi Pacific."

Your Economic Development and Budget Committee RECOMMENDS the following:

- 1. That Bill _______ (2019), as revised herein and attached hereto, entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT, MAUI REDEVELOPMENT PROGRAM; TOTAL OPERATING APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)," be PASSED ON FIRST READING and be ORDERED TO PRINT; and
- 2. That County Communication 18-391 be FILED.
