## Organizational Chart

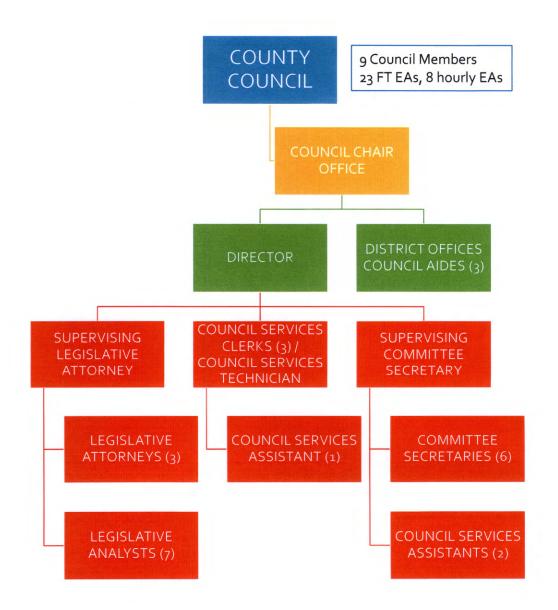
