- 1. Explain the purpose and justification for these three new grants (Fiscal Year 2020 Budget bill, page 19):
 - a. Pioneer Mill Office Restoration Plan, \$30,000
 - b. Dune and Shoreline Management, \$100,000
 - c. Transit Oriented Development, \$100,000 (KK)
- 2. What percentage of your Department's actual cost of processing building permits is covered by building permit and development fees? (SS)
- 3. Why haven't Department of Planning's permit fees been increased to better reflect the actual costs of providing those services? When were these fees last increased? (SS)
- 4. How many applications received each year are for two or more permits and receive the 50 percent discount for concurrent

 - c. Describe the SMCP Urban Design and Physical Form Study, the MIP baseline monitoring report, and the Coastal Viewplane Study update. What will these studies achieve, and what improvements will the Department make based on the results of these studies and reports? (MM)
- 6. As it relates to Index Code 909185B, Sub-Object Code 6317, County grant subsidy under Shoreline Management (Budget Details, page 14-12):
 - a. Are there specific locations for which this grant is designated?
