SUBJECT: FISCAL YEAR ("FY") 2020 BUDGET (OCC-1)(EDB-1)

Thank you for your letter dated April 1, 2019, requesting responses to the following questions:

- 1. What improvements were made to the Council Chamber with the \$100,000 appropriated in the FY 2019 Budget?
- 2. Provide information on the additional \$15,000 needed for document imaging activities.

Regarding your inquiries above, I offer the following responses:

## 1. What improvements were made to the Council Chamber with the \$100,000 appropriated in the FY 2019 Budget?

During the Budget and Finance ("BF") Committee's deliberations on the proposed FY '19 budget, the BF Committee unilaterally added \$100,000 to the Office of the County Clerk's ("OCC") FY '19 budget proposal for "Council Chamber improvements – soundproof/security". Please see attached Exhibit "1", depicting the changes made by the Council to the OCC's FY '19 budget proposal.

To date, the OCC has not expended any of these funds. The OCC has met with Council Chair Kelly King on some options to consider for soundproofing and security improvements to the 8<sup>th</sup> floor lobby and Council Chamber. Upon Council Chair King's approval for expenditure of these funds, the Office of the County Clerk will proceed with improvements. Committee Chair Keani N.W. Rawlins-Fernandez April 4, 2019

Based on security concerns for the Council Members, I will not disclose publicly the security upgrades being considered or those currently in place on the 8<sup>th</sup> floor and in the Council Chamber. If you require further information on security improvements to the Council Chamber, please contact me directly.

## 2. Provide information on the additional \$15,000 needed for document imaging activities.

Since 2014, the OCC has undergone various imaging projects primarily to provide more of the County's records to the public, which we hope will promote accessibility, transparency and accountability. As an additional benefit, imaging of records also allows the OCC to reduce its' storage costs.

Our hope is that in FY '20 we will have imaged all of our records stored offsite and the vast majority of records that we store on-site, with implementation of a public portal to access all of these documents by end of FY '20. Records we retain date back to 1904.

The OCC has issued a request for proposals for document imaging activities that will close in April 2019, with review of the proposals and procurement contest period to end approximately in May 2019. The OCC anticipates completion of the imaging project before the end of December 2019, with file numbering/naming and post project corrections anticipated to be completed by December 2020.
