- 4. What are the 10 FY 18 departments approved to move forward with reorganization requests? How many of the reorganizations are completed, and if not completed what percentage has been completed (Pg. 359 Narrative)
- 5. What are the 16 FY 19 departments approved to date to move forward with reoganization requests and what stage of reorganization are they at? (Pg. 359 of Narrative)
