- Legislation: Fiscal Year 2020 Budget Bill Bill 36 (2019)
- Proposer: Council Chair Kelly T. King
- Description: Amend Bill 36 (2019) to make additional adjustments for Sunday operations at the Central Maui Landfill as follows:
 - Department of Environmental Management, Solid Waste Administration Program – Solid Waste Management Fund – Reduce fringe benefit and administrative overhead costs corresponding to salary reduction noted below.
 - 2) Department of Environmental Management, Solid Waste Operations Program – Solid Waste Management Fund:
 - a. Reduce salaries by \$7,179 to reflect the deletion of three Landfill Attendants and one Laborer I (instead of two Landfill Operators, one Landfill Attendant, and one Laborer I), and nine months (instead of full year) of salary for two retained Landfill Attendant positions.
 - b. Increase tires and tubes by \$463.
 - c. Delete gasoline, diesel, oil, etc. expansion request in the amount of \$6,549.
 - d. Increase Repairs & Maintenance Services/Contracts expansion request by \$9,379.
 - e. Delete traffic signs expansion request in the amount of \$1,000.
 - f. Delete Repairs & Maintenance Others expansion request in the amount of \$5,968.
 - g. Delete Landfill Cover Costs expansion request in the amount of \$84,868.
 - 3) Increase OPEB contributions by the corresponding total amount.
- Motion: Move to amend pages 4, 5, and 8 of Bill 36 (2019):
 - 1) Department of Environmental Management, Solid Waste Administration Program – Solid Waste Management Fund, by reducing the following:
 - a. Contribution to General Fund ERS and FICA by \$2,129.
 - b. Contribution to General Fund EUTF by \$1,263.
 - c. Contribution to General Fund OPEB by \$643.
 - d. Administrative Overhead Charge by \$2,384.
 - 2) Department of Environmental Management, Solid Waste Operations Program – Solid Waste Management Fund, by reducing the following:
 - a. Category "A" Salaries by an additional \$7,179.

- b. Category "B" Operations by an additional \$88,543.
- 3) Department of Finance, Financial Services Program, Countywide Costs, Post-Employment Obligations, by increasing Category "B" Operations by \$102,141.
