Subject: Makila development for affordable housing

Aloha,

We are writing in opposition to the planned development project below Makila and Launiupoko for the following reasons:

Although everyone is aware of the need for affordable housing, we are not convinced that the home labeled as such in this proposal will really be in that price category.

A change from Ag to urban seems to be an attempt by the developers to use affordable housing as a way to fast track their plan to built multimillion dollar mansions along with them in order to make the highest financial "profit" for their benefit only....It would not help the community, or the land, or the environment, or the coral reefs in any way...Actually it would be harmful with runoff into the oceans, etc.

These same developers have already built 120 plus multimillion dollar mansions in the last seven to ten years just in Launiupoko alone!! These are Spec homes with an average price of 3 million. If this project was just about building TRUELY affordable homes, then it would be PONO.

While they're at it, why not put in some large, beautiful parks to surround the development instead of more unaffordable mansions.

What that area needs is a beautiful, very large, grassy park(s) across the hwy from the small, crowded Launiupoko Beach park. That would be the right kind of community plan.
