Aloha Council member Lee,

We have heard that the fees for Waiehu Golf course have been changed for the tourist to weekdays \$63 and for weekends and Holidays \$75 and for non Maui county residents(neighbor island and state ID)weekdays \$35 and on weekends and Holidays to \$40. Those fees are rather high for a municipal golf course when you compare it to the other municipal golf courses in Hawaii. All the other golf courses on Maui are privately owned which allows those courses to change their rates to influence play to the time of season or to playing conditions. Here at Waiehu the rates stay the same all year. For instance The Dunes at Maui Lani has a summer special of \$58 with cart for tourist; Kahili the other week had a \$69 special because they has just aerated their greens. All the other privately owned golf courses are able to change their rates during the winter months (raise their rates) and during the summer months (lower rates) and offer other specials to help attract golfers. At Waiehu we are not able to change our rates so we need to keep our rates reasonable so we are able to compete with the other golf courses as they lower or raise there rates. At Waiehu we rely on the tourist playing at Waiehu 2 or 3 times instead of just once during there stay here. This is also true for our neighbor island players to have them play here more then once is where we make our revenue from not just playing here once!! Waiehu golf course is not here for profit it is here to provide the Maui county residents and visitors an affordable ,fun,outdoor recreation that they can enjoy!!!t's a park that the golf fees help to defray the costs on.

We are hoping you are able to amend these new rates so that the golf course can keep revenue coming in. These new rates could cause some major loss of revenue!!I have attached the rates of the other municipal golf courses in Hawaii so you can have a comparison of the same type of golf courses.
