# ROYAL PATENT.

**KAMEHAMEHA III.**, By the grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands, by this His Royal Patent, makes known unto all men, that he has for himself and his successors in office, this day granted and given, absolutely, in Fee Simple unto Robert Robinson, his faithful and loyally disposed subject for the consideration of three hundred and nineteen dollars, paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that certain piece of Land, situated at Panaloa, Hamakua, in the Island of Hawaii, and described as follows:

Commencing at the N.W. angle of said lot in the middle of the ravine dividing this land from Paikini, and running S. 70° E. 100 feet to the back of the ravine, thence along the Government road towards Aamann S. 70° E. 73.5 feet, S. 74 1/2° E. 49.5 feet, S. 75 1/2° E. 50.3 feet, to the back of the ravine on the back side of this land, thence S. 70° E. 10.5 feet to the middle of the ravine, thence along the boundary of Aamann up the back branch of the ravine S. 47° N. 140 feet, S. 3° E. 132 feet, S. 50° E. 355 feet, S. 9° N. 450 feet, S. 17 1/2° N. 124.8 feet, to a Kukui tree, thence S. 10° N. 2300 feet to a stake on the top of a hill near an ancient ditch, thence N. 80° N. 3570 feet, across to the ravine which forms the Western boundary of this land, thence down the middle of said ravine, along the boundary of Kakaalaka and Paikini N. 20° E. 568 feet, N. 47° E. 74.8 feet, N. 12 1/2° E. 300 feet, N. 12 1/2° N. 328 feet, N. 12 1/2° E. 455 feet, N. 22 1/2° E. 466 feet, N. 46 1/2° E. 415 feet, N. 15 1/2° E. 370 feet, N. 52 1/2° E. 370 feet, N. 28 1/2° E. 800 feet, N. 31 1/2° E. 615 feet to the point of commencement.

*his* Heirs and Assigns forever, subject to the taxes to be from time to time imposed  
 by the Legislative Council equally, upon all landed Property held in Fee Simple.

 Hawaiian Islands to be affixed, at Honolulu, this *26* day of  
*October* 1852.
