CULTURAL RESOURCES COMMISSION REVIEW OF THE DRAFT PARKING ACTION PLAN FOR WAILUKU TOWN AND **LAHAINA TOWN**

At its July 5, 2018 meeting, the Cultural Resources Commission (Commission) reviewed the Draft Parking Action Plan (Plan) as it relates to County Historic Districts Nos. 1 and 2 in Lahaina. The Commission offered the following comments on the draft plan:

- 1. The Commission generally supports the Plan.
- 2. The Commission supports amendments to Tile 19, Maui County Code (if needed) to allow the County to collect parking revenue on public property in County Historic Districts Nos. 1 and 2.
- 3. The Commission supports providing discounted parking rates for residents.
- 4. The Commission agrees with starting paid parking later in the day (after 10:00 a.m.) so that surfers and fishermen can park for free in the mornings.
- 5. The Commission supports a two-to-three hour time limit for on-street parking.
- 6. The Commission supports using parking revenue for beautification (landscaping installation and maintenance) and additional way finding signage.
- 7. The Commission recommends using parking revenue to fund additional zoning enforcement efforts in County Historic Districts Nos. 1 and 2.
- 8. The Commission should be involved in developing way finding signage.
