**SUBJECT: COUNTY-OWNED PARCEL ON NORTH PAPA AVENUE
(KAHULUI) (HHT-14)**

This is in response to your letter dated July 11, 2017, in which you ask if County's in-house engineers can assist with evaluating the existing structures on the subject property and determine suitability for use.

While the Department of Public Works (Department) does have engineers on staff, none are structural engineers, and the Department does not believe that use of staff engineers would be the best option for evaluating the structures.

In a letter to you dated July 10, 2017, the Department of Housing and Human Concerns (DHHC) indicated that they are in the process of preparing an RFP to hire a structural engineer to conduct an assessment of the structures. The assessment scope will likely include, but not be limited to: general physical condition; structural soundness; water/mold/insect/drainage issues; condition of utility services, roofing, windows and interior elements; building code issues; and an opinion of probable repair costs.
