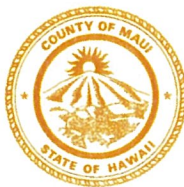

WHEREAS, by correspondence dated October 28, 2019, Mayor Michael P. Victorino notified the Council he nominated Seward Akahi to the Board of Ethics for the County of Maui for a term expiring on March 31, 2022, to fill a vacancy replacing Napua Grieg, pursuant to Sections 10-2 and 13-2, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended ("Charter"); and


WHEREAS, Charter Section 13-2, requires the Mayor's nominee to be approved by the Council; and
