A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRAFFIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that unsafe driving
- 2 conditions may be created on two-lane roadways where the lead
- 3 vehicle is moving slowly, with a back-up of vehicles behind it,
- 4 and traffic moving in the opposite direction makes it unsafe to
- 5 pass. This situation is frequently encountered on Hāna Highway,
- 6 from Mile Marker 00 to Mile Marker 34, where visibility around
- 7 turns is inhibited because of the natural contours of the road.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to require the driver of the lead
- 9 vehicle on Hāna Highway, from Mile Marker 00 to Mile Marker 34,
- 10 to use turnouts and allow vehicles to pass, thereby promoting
- 11 traffic safety on this roadway.
- SECTION 2. Section 291C-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by adding a new subsection d to read as follows:
- "§291C-41 Drive on right side of roadway; exceptions. (a)
- 15 Upon all roadways of sufficient width a vehicle shall be driven
- 16 upon the right half of the roadway, except as follows:

- 1 (1) When overtaking and passing another vehicle
- 2 proceeding in the same direction under the rules governing such
- 3 movement;
- 4 (2) When an obstruction exists making it necessary to
- 5 drive to the left of the center of the highway; provided any
- 6 person so doing shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles
- 7 traveling in the proper direction upon the unobstructed portion
- 8 of the highway within such distance as to constitute an
- 9 immediate hazard;
- 10 (3) Upon a roadway divided into three marked lanes
- 11 for traffic under the rules applicable thereon; or
- 12 (4) Upon a roadway designated and signposted one-way
- 13 traffic.
- 14 (b) Upon all roadways any vehicle proceeding at less than
- 15 the normal speed of traffic at the time and place and under the
- 16 conditions then existing shall be driven in the right-hand lane
- 17 then available for traffic, or as close as practicable to the
- 18 right-hand curb or edge of the roadway, except when overtaking
- 19 and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction or
- 20 when preparing for a left turn at an intersection or into a
- 21 private road or driveway.

- 1 (c) Upon any roadway having four or more lanes for moving
- 2 traffic and providing for two-way movement of traffic, no
- 3 vehicle shall be driven to the left of the center line of the
- 4 roadway, except when authorized by official traffic-control
- 5 devices designating certain lanes to the left side of the center
- 6 of the roadway for use by traffic not otherwise permitted to use
- 7 such lanes, or except as permitted under subsection (a)(2). This
- 8 subsection shall not be construed to prohibit the crossing of
- 9 the center line in making a left turn into or from an alley,
- 10 private road, or driveway.
- 11 (d) Upon Hāna Highway, from Mile Marker 00 to Mile Marker
- 12 34, where passing is unsafe because of traffic in the opposite
- 13 direction or other conditions, any vehicle proceeding upon the
- 14 roadway, behind which five or more vehicles are formed in line,
- 15 must turn off the roadway at the nearest place designated as a
- 16 turnout by signs erected by the authority having jurisdiction
- 17 over the roadway, or wherever sufficient area for a safe turnout
- 18 exists, in order to permit the vehicles following it to
- 19 proceed."
- 20 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
