SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4988, Bill No. 36 (2019), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2020 Budget", Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2020, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Office of the Mayor, by adding a new appropriation, entitled "State of Hawaii – Upcountry Maui Agricultural Park, Maui Water System Improvements," in the amount of \$3,500,000, to read as follows:
