Both my wife and I have professional level jobs in education. But we cannot afford to buy a home for the current prices in the housing market in Hāna. Currently our family is living in teacher housing, in a year or two, we do not know where we will be able to live. The Wākiu Affordable Housing project will open doors for many families who are currently living in single-family homes with two to three generations occupying them and filled to capacity. I urge this committee to support this project.
