Chair and Members:

Your Economic Development and Budget Committee, having met on December 5, 2019, makes reference to County Communication 19-281, from Council Vice-Chair Keani N.W. Rawlins-Fernandez, relating to amendments to Appendix A, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues -Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year ("FY") 2020.

By correspondence dated September 26, 2019, the Budget Director transmitted a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND HUMAN CONCERNS (STRATEGIC PREVENTION FRAMEWORK PARTNERSHIPS FOR SUCCESS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs, FY 2020 Budget, by increasing the grant appropriation for the Department of Housing and Human Concerns, Strategic Prevention Framework Partnerships for Success, by \$110,000 for the continued development and coordination of the County's substance abuse prevention system.

According to the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration's website, "the purpose of this grant program is to prevent the onset and reduce the progression of substance abuse and its related

problems while strengthening prevention capacity and infrastructure at the community level."

The Director of Housing and Human Concerns said the Department utilizes this grant to provide training to those who work with youth in primary prevention of substance abuse.

Your Committee voted 6-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading. Committee Chair Rawlins-Fernandez and members Kama, Lee, Molina, Sinenci, and Sugimura voted "aye." Committee Vice-Chair King and members Hokama and Paltin were excused.

Your Committee is in receipt of a revised proposed bill, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions, including adjustments to reflect the expected passage of other pending legislation.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1.
