SUBJECT: NEW KAHULUI COMMUNITY CENTER FACILITY (HFC-7)

Thank you for your letter dated February 11, 2019 regarding the above-referenced subject matter. The Department of Public Works evaluated the seven (7) acre parcel and offers the following:

The subject parcel was created as part of the Maui Lani Subdivision, Subdivision File No. 3.2327, which received final approval on September 12, 2017. A copy of the final plat is attached, as well as a close-up view of Lot 12-A-1-F, the subject lot now designated as TMK: (2) 3-8-007:180.

We note that the land is quite flat and, therefore, easily graded. We are not knowledgeable as to the probability or possible existence of burials on this property and that should be inquired of the landowner.

As to land area, the parcel has a gross area of 7.310 acres, with existing Easement 1 which is an access easement for Lot 12-A-3, the new Central Maui Park. Easement 1 is 0.372 acres, leaving a net usable area of 6.938 acres for the subject parcel.

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Access is straightforward, as the future continuation of Kamehameha Avenue continues along the entire northern border of the subject parcel and is denoted as Easement A-4 for access purposes to the subject parcel.

Though the lot is slightly irregular, it does appear to be developable for the purpose of a community center with direct access through its southern border to the new Central Maui Park.
