WHEREAS, by correspondence dated December 20, 2019, Mayor Michael P. Victorino notified the Council he nominated Bryan Otani to the Kula Agricultural Park Committee for a term expiring on March 31, 2022, to fill a vacancy replacing Brandon Shim, pursuant to Section 22.04A.070, Maui County Code ("MCC"); and


