I am skeptical of the rational that this need would defray costs and expenses for those that have built on the West End. If you can't afford it don't build it. Also many of these owners are part timers and not residents. I believe the residents with history and employment on Molokai should have a preference for the available yet to be determined allocations. I would also like to have an enforced spacing between each short term rental home, say 250' to 500' between each home. This would allow for the prevention of the congestion of rentals that are presently proliferating in places such as Puko'o and Waialua. It is unfortunate that no one stood up for limiting the STRHS in Waialua like they are in Puko'o. Waialua definitely has too many, all owned by off-islanders. Properly enforced and regulated short term rental homes could provide the County with much needed tax revenues and benefit our Community. Community input is vital and while it is easier to say "None", I don't think that is the answer. We have existed with the present situation for a while without a tremendous amount of "flack", but it is time to get it right.
