I write on behalf of myself and my extended family in support of maintaining legally permitted Short Term Rentals on Molokai and in support of the County Council's Resolution 17-74, as submitted, placing a cap on the number of STRH permits on Molokai at 40 island-wide (15 west end, 10 central, 15 east end).

My family owns a house outside Kaunakakai - 226 Kahinani Place - that has a current STRH permit (STMO 2015/0002). The house is named after my grandfather, Kimo's Hale. This property has been a part of my family's heritage for over 55 years. My father, grandfather and grandmother were residents of Oahu. My grandfather Kimo worked with Molokai residents to help establish the electric power grid on Molokai.

Our Kimo's Hale is situated among the homes of long-time family acquaintances who have supported us in establishing the home as a Short Term Rental and who have recently used the home for their family members during a memorial service.

Managing the house as a STRH allows my family to maintain this important part of our heritage.
