Our experience is representative of upwards of 100 competitive canoe clubs for each race, many of which field more crews than Lokahi.

We are sensitive to the need to control resources used by short-term visitors, as we see abuse here on O`ahu. We believe a reasonable and responsible approach is to limit permit numbers rather than prohibit permits entirely.
