SUBJECT: **RELOCATING THE MOLOKAI POLICE STATION** (EDB-42)

Thank you for your letter dated September 3, 2019 requesting information to the following:

- 1. A breakdown of all previous and current funding approved for the Molokai Police Station, including the cost of the preliminary Environmental Assessment.
 - \$884 was paid to Valley Isle Appraisal Company in 2016 for an appraisal of 2115 Maunaloa Highway, Kaunakakai. This was one of the properties we were looking at for the new Molokai District Station.
 - \$36,531 has been encumbered to fund a contract with Group 70 International, Inc. to provide services for preliminary development planning for the proposed new Molokai District Station.
 - \$3,640 has been paid to Allan T. Shisido dba Island Appraisals for the property located at 2130 Maunaloa Highway, Kaunakakai.

2. A list of other County agencies interested in using the parcel.

Currently, a list of other County agencies interested in using the parcel does not exist. However, there is a possibility that other County agencies could relocate to this parcel in the future.

3. A plan for the existing police station and neighboring fire station after the Department of Police relocates.

The proposed plan is to utilize it as a sub-station for the Police Bicycle Patrol Program, which is in line with the Molokai Community Plan to:

No. 9.2.07: Encourage the implementation of a Police Bicycle Patrol Program on Molokai.
