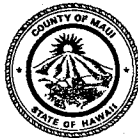

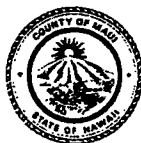

Will you please provide an opinion as to the legal limits of the use of requirements or preferences based on current state, county or district residency; residency for a specified period of time; owner-occupancy; a resident's work location; or other criteria designed to give housing priority to County of Maui residents?

Please also indicate whether any such requirements or preferences would be limited to housing developed within a 2.96, 201H, or similar process with "affordable housing" requirements, or could those requirements or preferences be conditions of a project approval such as zoning, Special Management Area or District Boundary Amendment conditions.

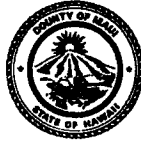
