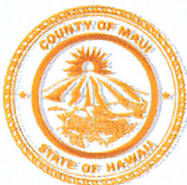
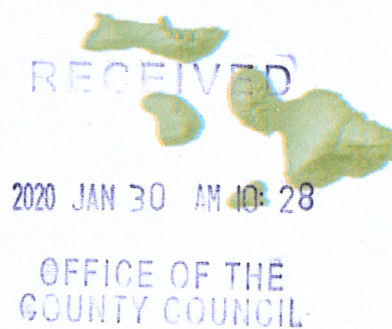

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI  
AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES;  
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, SPECIAL MAINTENANCE PROGRAM – GENERAL FUND;  
COUNTYWIDE, ROAD IMPROVEMENTS, HIGHWAY FUND;  
MAKAWAO-PUKALANI-KULA COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, ROAD IMPROVEMENTS, HIGHWAY FUND;  
TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS; AND  
TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1.
