Your Economic Development and Budget Committee, having met on February 6, 2020, makes reference to the following:

1. County Communication 20-52, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4985, BILL NO. 34 (2019), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI ISSUANCE, SALE AND DELIVERY OF SAID BONDS (DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT - CML PHASE VB EXTENSION LEACHATE RECIRCULATION SYSTEM)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2020 general obligation bond authorization ordinance under the Department of Environmental Management, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Sanitation, by adding the CML Phase VB Extension Leachate Recirculation System project in the amount of \$650,000, for design and construction of infrastructure to expand the recirculation of leachate into the Phase VB Extension waste mass.

County Communication 20-53, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4985, BILL NO. 34 (2019), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI ISSUANCE, SALE AND DELIVERY OF SAID BONDS (DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT - CML EXTENSION OF

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2020 general obligation bond authorization ordinance under the Department of Environmental Management, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Sanitation, by adding the CML Extension of Primary Litter Screen and Drainage Improvements project in the amount of \$500,000, to design and construct an extension to the 50-foot high litter screens along the Pulehu Road property line to service the new Phase VB Extension disposal cell.

Your Committee notes the CML Phase VB Extension Leachate Recirculation System project and the CML Extension of Primary Litter Screen and Drainage Improvements project are included in the FY 2020 Budget. However, the Council did not authorize the use of bond funds for the project. These bills would grant bond authorization for the respective projects.

A representative of the Department of Environmental Management explained that leachate is the substance that settles at the bottom of landfill when liquid passes through the waste. The recirculation system will collect the leachate and reinsert it through the landfill, cleaning the leachate.

The Representative also explained that the litter screens the Department will obtain will be 30 feet tall. The screen size was selected in consideration of criteria such as the capacity of the landfill, the cost weighted against the benefits of larger screens, and the height limits within the property's land use designations.

Your Committee voted 9-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bills on first reading and filing of the communications. Committee Chair

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4985, BILL NO. 34 (2019), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI ISSUANCE, SALE AND DELIVERY OF SAID BONDS (DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT – CML PHASE VB EXTENSION LEACHATE RECIRCULATION SYSTEM)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4985, Bill No. 34 (2019), is amended by amending Section 1 to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. <u>Authorization of General Obligation Bonds</u>. Pursuant to Chapter 47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and particularly Part I thereof, there are hereby authorized to be issued and sold from time to time general obligation bonds of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii (the "County") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed [\$65,777,700] \$66,427,700 (the "Bonds"), the proceeds derived from the sale of which shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of appropriations for the public improvements of the County described in Section 2 hereof."

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4985, Bill No. 34 (2019), is amended by amending Section 2 to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. <u>Disposition of Bond Proceeds</u>. All or any portion of the proceeds derived from the sale of the Bonds or any notes issued in anticipation of the Bonds shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of any of the public improvements listed below in accordance with appropriations contained in the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget, including amendments and supplements thereto, duly approved by the Council of the County (the "Council") for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 (the "Fiscal Year 2020 Budget"); provided, however, that pursuant to Section 47-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the part of such proceeds which are in excess of the amounts required for the purposes for which the Bonds are initially issued from time to time, or which may not be applied to such purposes, or which the Council deems should not be applied to such

purposes, may be applied to finance such other public improvements of the County as the Council shall, by ordinance approved by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of all of its members, determine; and provided further that the actual use and application of the proceeds of Bonds issued pursuant to this ordinance shall not in any way affect the validity or legality of such Bonds. No proceeds of the Bonds shall be applied to any public improvement listed in this section unless and until there shall be a valid appropriation of general obligation bond proceeds in effect for such public improvement. The public improvements provided for or to be provided for in the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget, to be financed with proceeds from the sale of the Bonds, are as follows:
