Chair and Members:

Your Economic Development and Budget Committee, having met on April 24, 2020, makes reference to County Communication 20-111, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF POLICE, WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, GOVERNMENT FACILITIES, BOND FUND, WAILUKU POLICE STATION FUEL TANK REPLACEMENT; TOTAL OPERATING APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2020 Budget by: 1) increasing Bond/Lapsed Bond by \$450,500; 2) amending Section 4.F.2.a.(1), Department of Police ("Department"), Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Government Facilities, Bond Fund, by adding a project entitled "Wailuku Police Station Fuel Tank Replacement" in the amount of \$450,500; and 3) adjusting the totals accordingly.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF

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POLICE, WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA (WAILUKU POLICE STATION FUEL TANK REPLACEMENT)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2020 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by adding an appropriation for the Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area for a project entitled "Wailuku Police Station Fuel Tank Replacement," under the Department of Police, in the amount of \$450,500. The project is described as "Design, construction, and renovation at the Wailuku Police Station for fuel tank replacement."

3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4985, BILL NO. 34 (2019), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI ISSUANCE, SALE AND DELIVERY OF SAID BONDS (DEPARTMENT OF POLICE – WAILUKU POLICE STATION FUEL TANK REPLACEMENT)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2020 general obligation bond authorization ordinance by adding an appropriation for the Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Government Facilities, for a project entitled "Wailuku Police Station Fuel Tank Replacement," in the amount of \$450,500, under the Department of Police.

The Communication attached a document from the Department of Finance, dated November 12, 2019, entitled "BID RESULTS." The Budget Director said enactment of the proposed bills will provide funding for the contract awarded to the successful bidder.

Your Committees notes \$1,500,000 in general obligation bonds were approved in the FY 2020 Budget for Wailuku Police Station Improvements (CBS-5535).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4985, Bill No. 34 (2019), is amended by amending Section 1 to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. Authorization of General Obligation Bonds. Pursuant to Chapter 47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and particularly Part I thereof, there are hereby authorized to be issued and sold from time to time general obligation bonds of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii (the "County") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed [\$70,600,580] \$71,051,080 (the "Bonds"), the proceeds derived from the sale of which shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of appropriations for the public improvements of the County described in Section 2 hereof."

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4985, Bill No. 34 (2019), is amended by amending Section 2 to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. <u>Disposition of Bond Proceeds</u>. All or any portion of the proceeds derived from the sale of the Bonds or any notes issued in anticipation of the Bonds shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of any of the public improvements listed below in accordance with appropriations contained in the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget, including amendments and supplements thereto, duly approved by the Council of the County (the "Council") for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 (the "Fiscal Year 2020 Budget"); provided, however, that pursuant to Section 47-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the part of such proceeds which are in excess of the amounts required for the purposes for which the Bonds are initially issued from time to time, or which may not be applied to such purposes, or which the Council deems should not be applied to such

purposes, may be applied to finance such other public improvements of the County as the Council shall, by ordinance approved by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of all of its members, determine; and provided further that the actual use and application of the proceeds of Bonds issued pursuant to this ordinance shall not in any way affect the validity or legality of such Bonds. No proceeds of the Bonds shall be applied to any public improvement listed in this section unless and until there shall be a valid appropriation of general obligation bond proceeds in effect for such public improvement. The public improvements provided for or to be provided for in the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget, to be financed with proceeds from the sale of the Bonds, are as follows:
