SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET, APPENDIX A, PART I GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES (DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE, CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT (CARES ACT))

I am transmitting the attached proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES – SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAM, DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE (CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT (CARES Act))."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to add an appropriation, entitled "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act)," under the Department of Finance for \$67,000,000. Through the State of Hawaii, the County of Maui may receive \$66,598,757 for Fiscal Year 2020 to be used for COVID-19 pursuant to Public Law 116-136 and associated guidance issued by appropriate federal agencies.

The CARES Act, Public Law 116-136, was enacted on March 27, 2020, to address the extensive economic fallout of the COVID-19 pandemic. Through the CARES Act, the State of Hawaii was provided \$1,250,000,000 for expenditures that are necessary and incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to COVID-19; not accounted for in the budget most recently approved as of March 27, 2020, for state government; and incurred between March 1, 2020 and December 31, 2020.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4988, Bill No. 36 (2019), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2020 Budget", Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2020, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Department of Finance, by adding an appropriation, entitled "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act)" in the amount of \$67,000,000, to read as follows:

"3. Department of Finance

 a. Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Program (1) Provided, that disbursement for salaries and premium pay is limited to 6.0 Limited Term Appointment (LTA) equivalent personnel. 	602,417
 b. Periodic Motor Vehicle Inspection Program (1) Provided, that disbursement for salaries and premium pay is limited to 5.0 LTA equivalent personnel. 	517,624
 c. State Disability and Communications Board (DCAB) Program (1) Provided, that disbursement for salaries and premium pay is limited to 0.3 LTA equivalent personnel. 	20,533
 d. State Identification (SID) Program (1) Provided, that disbursement for salaries and premium pay is limited to 2.0 LTA equivalent personnel. 	230,001
 e. State Motor Vehicle Registration Program (1) Provided, that disbursement for salaries and premium pay is limited to 4.0 LTA equivalent personnel. 	360,912
f. Coronavirus Relief Fund and other COVID-19 related grants	3,000,000
g. Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act)	67,000,000"
