A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI
AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I,
GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND
RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS,
DEPARTMENT OF POLICE
(MAUI POLICE FOUNDATION)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4988, Bill No. 36 (2019), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2020 Budget", Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2020, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Department of Police, by adding a new appropriation entitled "Maui Police Foundation" in the amount of \$51,000, to read as follows:

"10. Department of Police

a. Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP) Program	15,000
b. Community Oriented Policing Grant	200,970
c. Department of Health (DOH) Grants (1) Provided, that disbursement for salaries and premium pay is limited to 5.0 LTA equivalent personnel.	582,731

l. Paul Coverdell Forensic Sciences Improvement Act	5,000

m. State E911 Wireless Commission	2,084,376
n. State Farm Neighborhood Assist Grant	1,000
o. State and Federal Assets Forfeiture Program (1) Provided, that a quarterly report shall be submitted to Council on the use of forfeiture funds.	100,000
p. Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) - State Attorney General	55,000
q. <u>Maui Police Foundation</u>	<u>51,000"</u>
