A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION; COUNTYWIDE; COUNTYWIDE PARKS AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) IMPROVEMENTS; COUNTYWIDE PARK PLAYGROUND IMPROVEMENTS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4988, Bill No. 36 (2019), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2020 Budget", Appendix C – Capital Improvement Projects, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Department of Parks and Recreation, by expanding the project descriptions for 1) the Countywide Parks Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Improvements by adding "Begin implementation of ADA transition plan" and 2) the Countywide Park Playground Improvements by adding "Construct, repair, and replace playground equipment at Kalama Park Playground," to read as follows:
