### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4988, Bill No. 36 (2019), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2020 Budget", is hereby amended as it pertains to Section 3.B.9.c.(2)(iv), Office of the Mayor, Economic Development Program, Grants and disbursements for business development and technology, East Maui Economic Development and Cultural Programs, by 1) deleting proviso (1) relating to the East Maui Taro Festival, (2) by amending proviso (5) by deleting the phrase "- Hana Regatta", and (3) renumbering the remaining provisos, to read as follows:
