PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE
REVISED CHARTER OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI
(1983), AS AMENDED, TO ESTABLISH
STRICTER TERM LIMITS FOR THE MAYOR

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That in accordance with Section 14-1(1), Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended ("Charter"), it proposes that Subsection 5 of Section 7-2 of the Charter, pertaining to term limits for the mayor, be amended to read as follows:

"5. The voters of the county shall elect a mayor whose term of office shall be four (4) years beginning at twelve o'clock meridian on the second day of January following the mayor's election. A mayor shall not serve more than two [consecutive] full terms of office."; and

2. That material to be repealed is bracketed;

3. That, in accordance with Subsection 1 of Section 14-2 of the Charter, this Resolution be submitted to the voters of the County of Maui at the next General Election;

4. That the County Clerk prepare the necessary ballot for presentation to the voters at the next General Election;

5. That, in accordance with Section 14-1 of the Charter, it proposes that the following question be placed on the next General Election ballot:

"Shall the Charter be amended to establish stricter term limits for the Mayor by limiting the number of terms a person may serve as Mayor to two full terms?";

6. That, in accordance with Subsection 2 of Section 14-2 of the Charter, the County Clerk publish this proposed amendment as set forth in this Resolution in its entirety in a newspaper of general circulation;

7. That, upon approval by the majority of the voters voting on the proposed amendment, the amendment proposed by this Resolution will take effect on January 2, 2021;

8. That its express intent is that "full term" means any uninterrupted time in office for at least two years starting on the effective date of the amendment proposed by this Resolution or any later date; and

9. That certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor and the Corporation Counsel.
