

My name is Greg Jenkins and I am a resident of Maui County and County Employee going on 25 years. I am a strong supporter of affordable housing projects and support the (PSLU-56), CHANGE IN ZONING FOR THE PROPOSED KILOHANA MAKAI WORKFORCE HOUSING PROJECT. I am a beneficiary of affordable housing projects in Maui County as it enabled me to get a great first start for my initial family home on Molokai in 1999. After 10 years I was able to refinance and get off of my subsidized loan. I lived in my home for 20 years until family work requirements made it necessary to move back to Maui. The respect and care I had for my first home enabled me build equity that facilitated a reasonable transition into a housing market on Maui that was much more expensive at market value. Without affordable housing opportunities my family would not be where we are today. Thank you for your support of affordable housing and this projects process via a change in zoning of the land.
