As residents of Keawekapu Views since 1995, my family and I are against any changes from open space to R1 for this parcel on Wela St. Wayne Nishiki helped us to keep this area left open as a condition to have the subdivision of Kilohana Ridge approved. Why should we have to continually defend the protection of open parcels? The area between Kilohana & Keonekai is already densely populated. Traffic is terrible especially around 8am & 4pm when the hotel workers are arriving & leaving. The cars waiting to turn onto Piilani Hwy from Kilohana are backed up to Okululani. If there would be an emergency at this time it could impede emergency vehicles from getting to the area.

This land is also needed as a buffer between the ocean and the subdivisions along Wela St. & is also in the evacuation zone in the threat of a tsunami.
