Chair and Members:

Your Economic Development and Budget Committee, having met on August 4, 2020, makes reference to County Communication 20-344, from Council Vice-Chair Keani N.W. Rawlins-Fernandez, relating to amendments to Appendix A, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2021.

By correspondence dated July 13, 2020, the Budget Director transmitted a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF POLICE (MAUI POLICE FOUNDATION)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues - Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs, Fiscal Year 2021 Budget, by adding a new appropriation under the Department of Police entitled "Maui Police Foundation" in the amount of \$51,000, to acquire drones for the Traffic Section and a utility vehicle for the Support Services Section.

The Budget Director stated the grant would be for the purchase of drones and a utility vehicle by the Department of Police.

A representative of the Department of Police informed your Committee that the drones will be used by the Traffic Section for mapping fatal or near-fatal crash scenes and will allow for roadways to reopen more

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quickly. The software mapping program will be purchased with grant money, and these funds are solely for the purchase of the equipment. The Department also clarified the vehicle is for Citizens on Patrol under the Community Relations Section in the Support Services Bureau.

Your Committee voted 6-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading. Committee Chair Rawlins-Fernandez, Vice-Chair King, and members Lee, Molina, Sinenci, and Sugimura voted "aye." Committee members Hokama, Kama, and Paltin were excused.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5099, Bill No. 64 (2020), Draft 1, "Fiscal Year 2021 Budget", Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2021, is hereby as it pertains to the Department of Police, by adding a new appropriation entitled "Maui Police Foundation" in the amount of \$51,000, to read as follows:
