## A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.28.070, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO PLANNING COMMISSION AND ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Section 2.28.070, Maui County Code, is amended to read as

follows:

"2.28.070 Planning commission and advisory committee membership requirements. <u>A.</u> At least one member of each planning commission and [Hana] advisory committee [shall] <u>must</u> have demonstrated expertise in native Hawaiian traditional and customary practices, as evidenced by one or more of the following credentials:

1. A college degree in a relevant field, such as Hawaiian studies, native Hawaiian law, native Hawaiian traditional and customary practices, including traditional environmental practices, or related subject area.

2. Work history that demonstrates an appropriate level of knowledge in native Hawaiian traditional and customary practices, including traditional environmental practices.

3. Substantial experience as a native Hawaiian traditional and customary practitioner.

B. At least one member of each planning commission and advisory committee must have a background in conservation and natural resources/climate change, as evidenced by one or more of the following credentials:

<u>1.</u> <u>A college degree in a relevant field, including</u> <u>forestry, wildlife conservation, geology, environmental</u> <u>science, or marine biology.</u>

2. Work history sufficient to demonstrate an appropriate level of knowledge in the subject of land and natural resources, including parks and recreation, public lands management, natural area reserves, aquatic resources,

boating and recreation, forestry and wildlife, water resources management, or conservation and resources.

<u>3.</u> A dedicated leadership position in a nonprofit organization sufficient to demonstrate an appropriate level of knowledge in a subject matter as noted in the subject of land and natural resources, including parks and recreation, public lands management, natural area reserves, aquatic resources, boating and recreation, forestry and wildlife, water resources management, or conservation and resources."

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
