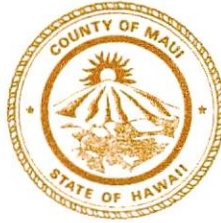


Dear Ms. Griffith:
