SUBJECT: 2019 MAUI AGRICULTURAL FESTIVAL AND 4-H LIVESTOCK FAIR, WAR MEMORIAL COMPLEX

(HFC-19)

At its meeting of May 13, 2019, the Healthy Families and Communities Committee discussed the upcoming Maui Agricultural Festival and 4-H Livestock Fair, sponsored by the County, to be held at the War Memorial Complex on June 1, 2019.

In its discussion, the Committee questioned the proper use of the County seal and logos on flyers used to promote this event and other County-sponsored events. The Committee noted some events in recent years have been promoted with flyers that include both the County seal and a logo of the Mayor's Office of Economic Development. Some examples are attached.

May I request your written response to the following:

1. Please advise whether there is a policy regarding the use of the County seal or logos on promotional materials for County-sponsored events. If so, please provide a copy of the policy. Does the policy account for Chapter 1.08, Maui County Code (which designates the County seal) and Section 5-3, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended (which grants the County Clerk "custody of the county seal")?

- 2. What guidance, if any, does the County provide to grant recipients on the use of the County seal and logos on promotional materials for their events?
- 3. Section 11.02.070, Maui County Code, provides that the Department of Transportation "may adopt an official logo for the County bus system." The attached examples show the Office of Economic Development has a logo. Which other agencies or program have logos? Under what authority were logos adopted? How are they used?















