AS IT PERTAINS TO DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE,
COUNTYWIDE COSTS, POST-EMPLOYMENT OBLIGATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5099, Bill No. 64 (2020), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2021 Budget", is hereby amended as it pertains to Section 3.B.4.f.14., Department of Finance, Countywide Costs, by amending the proviso for the Post-Employment Obligations, to read as follows:
