Chair and Members:

Your Economic Development and Budget Committee, having met on September 10, 2020, makes reference to County Communication 20-344, from Council Vice-Chair Keani N.W. Rawlins-Fernandez, relating to amendments to Appendix A, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year ("FY") 2021.

By correspondence dated August 31, 2020 the Budget Director transmitted a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND HUMAN CONCERNS, AGING AND DISABILITY RESOURCE CENTER (ADRC) EXPANSION."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues - Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs, FY 2021 Budget, by increasing the appropriation for the Department of Housing and Human Concerns, Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) Expansion, by \$92,000.

The Budget Director stated the Department of Housing and Human Concerns has received an additional \$92,000 in Federal funds from the State Executive Office on Aging, in addition to the \$825,000 appropriated in the FY 2021 Budget.

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The Director of Housing and Human Concerns informed your Committee the funds would be directed to seniors and family caregivers for services and support to reduce the impact of social isolation, which will include providing approximately 175 landlines or mobile devices to allow homebound program participants and their family caregivers to maintain contact with other family members and service providers. The funds will also be used to provide approximately 200 lifelike robotic animals called "Furry Friends" to assist with reducing the effects of social isolation.

Your Committee expressed support for the proposed services.

Your Committee voted 8-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading. Committee Chair Rawlins-Fernandez, Vice-Chair King, and members Kama, Lee, Molina, Paltin, Sinenci, and Sugimura voted "aye." Committee member Hokama was excused.

Your Economic Development and Budget Committee RECOMMENDS that Bill (2020), attached hereto, entitled "A BILL" FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND HUMAN CONCERNS, AGING AND DISABILITY RESOURCE CENTER (ADRC) EXPANSION," be PASSED ON FIRST READING and be ORDERED TO PRINT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5099, Bill No. 64 (2020), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2021 Budget", Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2021, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Department of Housing and Human Concerns by increasing the appropriation for the grant entitled "Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) Expansion" by \$92,000, to read as follows:
