Aloha AF Chair & Committee Members.

I am testifying **in favor today on item AH-11** require that housing provided pursuant to the Workforce Housing Policy or with Affordable Housing Fund money is kept affordable in perpetuity through deed restrictions. What a great word, "perpetuity", I'm so glad no one is afraid of this word anymore. I would also like to thank former West Maui Council member Elle Cochran for the introducing the originating item.

I am also in strong favor in allowing the County to be flexible, with Council approval, when providing affordable housing funds to projects that may need specific grant or loan provisions to secure additional financing.
