Dear Chief Faaumu:

Congratulation! This is to advise that the grant funds from the Dorcy Foundation are now available for the County of Maui to purchase a vehicle for the Maui Police Auxiliary Program. The grant will be administered through the Maui Police Foundation (MPF).

This grant from the Dorcy Foundation was provided to the MPF and made possible only because the MPF is a certified and registered a bona fide non-profit corporation and has the financial record keeping capabilities to provide appropriate and documented oversight. Previous efforts from the Maui Police Auxiliary to fund this project through other organizations were deemed unacceptable by the Dorcy Foundation and it was not until the MPF agreed to manage and administer the grant that Dorcy approved the grant.

Grant funds available to purchase the vehicle is not to exceed \$22,000. Any additional funds needed to complete this purchase are to be provided by others. Any excess funds remaining following the purchase of the vehicle are to be returned to the Maui Police Foundation.

In order to provide the oversight needed to appropriately administer the expenditure of this grant, the MPF is respectfully requesting a monthly status report on the progress of the purchase of this vehicle and any and all documentation supporting that purchase.
