Pros

Location near commercial and schools
Live/Work component of design
Large shade trees along Pi'ikea between sidewalk and street
Large shade trees throughout parking areas and around buildings
Clear, safe pathways and bike lanes throughout site

<u>Design elements that should be conditions placed by the Affordable Housing Committee</u>

Natural cross ventilation in all residential units:

open air exterior corridors windows on 2 sides of each unit security screen doors at each unit entrance door ceiling fans in all primary rooms optional only air conditioning

Hawaii's most serious future climate challenge will be extreme heat. Maui has trade winds and cool mountain air that falls down into Kihei every evening.

Affordable homes must take advantage of these free natural gifts. Designs that can only be comfortable with air conditioning contribute to energy waste, urban heat gain, pollution, extra monetary expense for residents and safety concerns during power failures.

With the above measures in place for all affordable housing, we will enhance the health, safety and welfare of residents and the community as a whole. This committee has the power to make standards that developers must incorporate into the designs of affordable housing.

Hale Mahaolu Ehiku is an excellent affordable housing project that has achieved these goals. It is located off Liloa Drive at Ehiku Loop. It is well worth a visit to appreciate the value of the design elements.

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
