Subject: Support for Maui County Social Host Ordinance

My name is Kristin Mills and I live in Pukalani. I work as a Public Health Educator for the Maui District Health Office and am also a mother of a teenager and a soon-to-be teenager.

As a mother of two youth and Public Health Educator who cares for ALL youth, I am writing to express my support for the Maui Social Host Ordinance, and to ask for you to vote in favor of it because our youth are still minors and need to be protected by the harms of underage drinking.

Many parents unfortunately view underage drinking as inevitable and have the misconception that having “house parties” to allow youth to drink under adult supervision as a safe option.

However, house parties are NOT safe havens. House parties and underage drinking lead to many other unhealthy behaviors, including increased physical fights, sexual assaults, alcohol poisoning, drunk driving, car crashes, and even death.

As a reminder, our youth are still minors and need our protection. Let’s protect our youth and reduce underage drinking (as well as its unhealthy aftermath) by adopting a social host ordinance.

In closing, underage drinking is never safe, even in the home. Please support a local social host ordinance.
