A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI  
AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I,  
GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND  
RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS,  
DEPARTMENT OF POLICE  
(HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREAS (HIDTA))

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5099, Bill No. 64 (2020), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2021 Budget", Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2021, is hereby as it pertains to the Department of Police, by increasing the appropriation for the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA) by \$65,450, to read as follows:

"9. Department of Police
