## AUTHORIZING THE COUNCIL CHAIR TO CONTRACT FOR A PERFORMANCE AUDIT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT RELATING TO THE COUNTY-EMPLOYEE PARKING SYSTEM

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 3-6 of the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, the Council has the authority to conduct investigations of the operation of any department or function of the County and any subject upon which the Council may legislate; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Management is responsible for the issuance of parking permits and collection of fees for the following County-employee parking lots in Wailuku, Maui, Hawaii:

- lot situated at the corner of Kaohu Street and Napua Street;
- lot situated on both the Wells Street side and the Kaohu Street side of the Kalana O Maui Building;
- lot situated in the covered parking area beneath Kalana O Maui Building;
- lot situated on the south side of Kaohu Street, at its intersection with South High Street; and
- lot situated at the Old Wailuku Post Office location; and

WHEREAS, parking adjacent to the Kalana O Maui Building is severely limited, resulting in employees parking their vehicles in nearby residential and commercial areas and in parking stalls with strict time limitations; and

WHEREAS, County civil service employees must wait an average of 10 years to receive a parking stall through the County-employee parking system; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Chapter 3.26, Maui County Code, the Employee Parking Fees Fund was established to provide funding for the maintenance, repair, security, safety, improvement, beautification, expansion, and other costs related to County-employee parking; and

WHEREAS, all fees paid by County employees for parking permits are deposited into the Employee Parking Fees Fund, for which the Fiscal Year 2020 anticipated revenue is \$64,130; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

- 1. That it authorizes the Council Chair to contract for a performance audit of the Department of Management relating to the County-employee parking system; and
- 2. That certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, the Managing Director, and the Director of Finance.
