PARKING MANAGEMENT PLAN

The Department of Management is working to create additional parking supply on campus, improve the management of parking assets, and locate fleet vehicles to improve efficiency.

SUPPLY- The Department requested a budget amendment to enable the two County owned lots makai of campus, on Kaohu Street, to be converted into temporary parking. The temporary materials will enable the County to create an additional 56 stalls while keeping options open for future office expansions and permanent parking solutions.

ASSET MANAGEMENT- The Department is researching new ways manage employee parking. to

DEMAND MANAGEMENT - The new Wailuku Town employee shuttle will provide an alternative for commuters and reduce the number of single occupant vehicles needing to park.

FLEET – Some vehicles go on multiple runs a day and some sit for days without moving. The Department is analyzing the best use and location for all fleet vehicles at Kalana O Maui.

Expanding existing parking areas and moving County divisions to the Service Center will increase the campus parking supply.


