Subject:	Testimony on amending Civic Center Project

Aloha Maui County Budget Committee,

I am writing in support of amending the Wailuku Civic Center Project for several reasons including these.

1. Opportunity cost

As many businesses are wrecked by too much investment as too much debt. When too much of your capital is invested in one project you inevitably miss out on other opportunities necessary for overall success. The project may be a <u>completed failure</u> because of the other unmet needs around it. How much more could be done for the community with \$66 million?

2. Cost v Benefits

The plan is to establish a free shuttle during construction so local businesses and workers will not suffer. If a free shuttle is sufficient why not start there? \$5 million would fund a robust, sustainable free shuttle program for ten years that would benefit everyone living and visiting Wailuku.
