A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE COMMISSION ON HEALING
SOLUTIONS FOR HOMELESSNESS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Section 2.31.020, Maui County Code, is amended by
amending Subsection B to read as follows:

“B. [One member from each of the nine council residency areas] Nine members must be appointed by the council. [These members must be fulltime residents of the respective residency areas.] Each member must demonstrate experience relevant to the commission to one of the nine council residency areas. One member must be a fulltime resident of Molokai, one member must be a fulltime resident of Lānaʻi, and one member must be a fulltime resident of East Maui.”

SECTION 2. Section 2.31.060, Maui County Code, is amended to read as
follows:

“**2.31.060 Meetings.** A. The commission must meet at least once a month.

B. The commission must elect a chair and a vice-chair from its members. Until the chair is elected, the director of housing and human concerns must preside, but without a vote.”

SECTION 3. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance takes effect upon its approval.
