Chair and Members:

Your Budget, Finance, and Economic Development Committee, having met on March 17, 2021, makes reference to County Communication 21-90, from Council Vice-Chair Keani N.W. Rawlins-Fernandez, relating to amendments to Capital Improvement Projects for Fiscal Year ("FY") 2021.

By correspondence dated March 1, 2021, the Budget Director transmitted the following:

A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE 1. AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES: DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT, WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY **PLAN** AREA. GOVERNMENT FACILITIES, BOND FUND, 60 NORTH CHURCH STREET BUILDING RENOVATIONS; CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS: TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2021 Budget by: 1) increasing Bond/Lapsed Bond by \$260,000; 2) amending Section 4.D.1.b.(1.), Department of Management, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Government Facilities, Bond Fund, by adding an appropriation, entitled "60 North Church Street Building Renovations," in the amount of \$260,000; and 3) adjusting the totals accordingly.

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2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT, WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, 60 NORTH CHURCH STREET BUILDING RENOVATIONS."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2021 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by adding an appropriation for the Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area for a project, entitled "60 North Church Street Building Renovations," under the Department of Management, in the amount of \$260,000, and a description of the project.

3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5101, BILL NO. 66 (2020), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI ISSUANCE, SALE AND DELIVERY OF SAID BONDS (DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT – 60 NORTH CHURCH STREET BUILDING RENOVATIONS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2021 General Obligation Bond Authorization ordinance by adding an appropriation for the Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Government Facilities, for a project, entitled "60 North Church Street Building Renovations," in the amount of \$260,000, under the Department of Management.

The Managing Director stated funding was appropriated in the FY 2020 Budget for renovations to the first floor of the Kalana o Maui Building for the Maui Emergency Management Agency. However, the Mayor allowed the funding to lapse because the County purchased the 60 North Church

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Street Building. The County plans to use a portion of the 60 North Church Street Building to house the Maui Emergency Management Agency.

He further explained the FY 2021 funds would be used for preliminary design of the new space, scoping for improvements, and a 10-year maintenance plan, and that funding for construction will be included in the Mayor's Proposed Budget for FY 2022 for Council's consideration.

Your Committee noted the lapsed funds did not impact necessary repairs such as mitigation due to rain damage to the Kalana o Maui Building.

Your Committee voted 7-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bills on first reading. Committee Chair Rawlins-Fernandez, Vice-Chair Paltin, and members King, Lee, Molina, Sinenci, and Sugimura voted "aye." Committee members Johnson and Kama were excused.

Your Committee is in receipt of revised proposed bills, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5101, Bill No. 66 (2020), is amended by amending Section 1 to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. Authorization of General Obligation Bonds. Pursuant to Chapter 47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and particularly Part I thereof, there are hereby authorized to be issued and sold from time to time general obligation bonds of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii (the "County") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed [\$77,770,321] \$78,030,321 (the "Bonds"), the proceeds derived from the sale of which shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of appropriations for the public improvements of the County described in Section 2 hereof."

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 5101, Bill No. 66 (2020), is amended by amending Section 2 to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. Disposition of Bond Proceeds. All or any portion of the proceeds derived from the sale of the Bonds or any notes issued in anticipation of the Bonds shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of any of the public improvements listed below in accordance with appropriations contained in the Fiscal Year 2021 Budget, including amendments and supplements thereto, duly approved by the Council of the County (the "Council") for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 (the "Fiscal Year 2021 Budget"); provided, however, that pursuant to Section 47-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the part of such proceeds which is in excess of the amounts required for the purposes for which the Bonds are initially issued from time to time, or which may not be applied to such purposes, or which the Council deems should not be applied

to such purposes, may be applied to finance such other public improvements of the County as the Council shall, by ordinance approved by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of all of its members, determine; and provided further that the actual use and application of the proceeds of Bonds issued pursuant to this ordinance shall not in any way affect the validity or legality of such Bonds. No proceeds of the Bonds shall be applied to any public improvement listed in this section unless and until there shall be a valid appropriation of general obligation bond proceeds in effect for such public improvement. The public improvements provided for or to be provided for in the Fiscal Year 2021 Budget, to be financed with proceeds from the sale of the Bonds, are as follows:
